- 1:30-5pm (\$20 additional) **Wet 'n' Wild** - Wet 'n' Wild Las Vegas is Nevada's largest water park with more than 25 slides and attractions, and a place for both thrill seekers and families to create lasting memories. For the more daring, the park features Rattler, the first slide of its kind in North America; Constrictor, voted a Top 5 water slide by the Travel Channel's Extreme Water Parks program; and a host of other fast, steep, twisting and multi-rider slides. For families and those desiring a more relaxing experience, there's Splash Island, the interactive children's area with kid friendly slides and a giant dumping bucket; Colorado Cooler, a 1,000-foot lazy river; and Red Rock Bay wave pool. With great amenities such as plenty of shaded areas, private cabanas to rent and misting systems, Wet 'n' Wild is an ideal location for all ages to beat the heat! - 9am-4pm **Hoover Dam** – Hoover Dam is located 30 miles southeast of Las Vegas on U.S. 93. Hoover Dam straddles the mighty Colorado River, which forms the border between the states of Nevada and Arizona. Considered to be the world's largest dam and an engineering marvel at the time of its construction in the 1930s, Hoover Dam brings much-needed water and power to the Southwest. The Bureau of Reclamation has offered tours of this National Historic Landmark since 1937. Today, the dam draws nearly a million visitors a year. The Dam Tour includes a 1-hour guided tour of the powerplant and passageways within the dam itself, and admission to the Visitor Center. Lunch will be provided.

- 9am-4pm **Adventuredome** - Located at the Circus Circus Resort, the Adventure Dome is a five acre indoor Adventure/Amusement Park for adults and children. Other rides include bumper cars, midway games, video arcade, rock climbing, FX movies, laser tag, miniature golf and clown shows.
