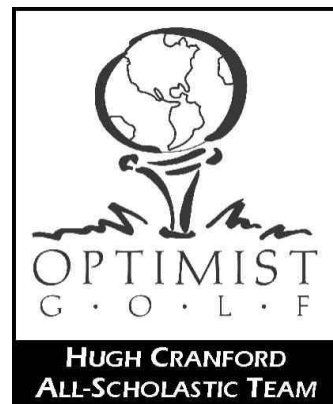


2013 Hugh Cranford All-Scholastic Team

The Hugh Cranford All-Scholastic Team is a special award recognizing the academic accomplishments and community service record of junior golfers who are past participants of Optimist International championship tournaments or District qualifiers.

The team will consist of up to five golfers who will be between the ages of 16 and 18 as of the last day of the Optimist International Junior Golf Championships (August 4, 2013). Junior golfers selected to the team will receive an automatic exemption into the championships and complimentary registration (the selected participant's registration fee—which is inclusive of tournament entry, hotel accommodations and meals—will be waived). The exemption includes an invitation to participate in the 2013 Optimist International Junior Golf Championships without having to play in a qualifying tournament. Junior golfers who are interested in applying should read the steps below and submit the attached application.



APPLICATION STEPS:

- Complete the application as indicated.
- Include a writing sample (250 to 500 words) on the topic indicated.
- Attach supporting documentation. The following items are the only items that will be accepted: current school transcript, most-recent grade report, and test results. Additional attachments will not be accepted.

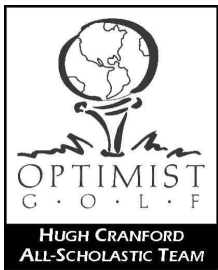


Hugh Cranford served as Executive Director of Optimist International from 1967 to 1986. Applicants will be considered based on their academic record but must also show that they have acceptable tournament experience to be able to compete at the international level. In addition, all applicants' community service experience will be reviewed for consideration for the "Bringing Out the Best In Kids" Community Service Award.

2013 Hugh Cranford All-Scholastic Team

The Hugh Cranford All-Scholastic Team will consist of up to five junior golfers with high school graduation years of 2013, 2014 or 2015 and who will not turn 19 on or before August 4, 2013. Applicants must have been a past participant in an Optimist International championship tournament or District qualifier to be considered. Applications must be postmarked by April 5, 2013. Applications will be reviewed by the Optimist Junior Golf Committee. Applicants will be notified of their status in writing by May 1, 2013. Junior golfers selected to the team receive an automatic exemption into the 2013 Optimist International Junior Golf Championships. Exemption includes an invitation to participate and the registration fee (inclusive of tournament entry, hotel accommodations and meals) will be waived. Applicants will be considered based on their academics, but must also show that they have acceptable golf experience to be able to play at the international level.
