### **HOW TO APPLY**

#### **Eligibility Criteria:**

The contest is open to students under the age of 18 as of October 1, 2017.

#### **Optimist District Competitions**

One Optimist District Winner will compete at the Optimist Regional Contest at Saint Louis University in St. Louis, Missouri via live streaming. The Regional Scholarship award is \$5000.
