FORMAT:	36– HOLE INDIVIDUAL STROKE PLAY IN AGE GROUPS: BOYS 11-13, GIRLS 11-13, GIRLS 14-18, BOYS 14-15, BOYS 16-18
PAIRINGS:	ROUND # 1 STARTING TIMES WILL BE POSTED BY NOON OCTOBER 30th THE SECOND ROUND WILL BE POSTED APPROXIMATELY TWO HOURS AFTER THE COMPLETION OF THE PREVIOUS ROUND.
COURSES:	36– HOLE INDIVIDUAL STROKE PLAY IN AGE GROUPS: BOYS 16-18 DIVISION (EL CAMPEON COURSE) BOYS 14-15 DIVISION (EL CAMPEON COURSE) GIRLS 14-18 DIVISION (LAS COLINAS COURSE) BOYS 11-13 DIVISION (LAS COLINAS COURSE) GIRLS 11-13 DIVISION (LAS COLINAS COURSE)
PRACTICE	Complimentary range balls available prior to tee off. Players wishing to hit balls after their round must make arrangements in the golf shop.
Hole Locations & Notice (NTP)	Each player will receive a Hole Location Sheet and a Notice to Players at their first tee.
SCORECARDS:	Each player will receive an Official Scorecard at their starting tee. Immediately following play please go to the Vista Room with your group for scoring and to pick up your box lunch.
PACE OF PLAY:	It is vitally important that the correct pace be maintained by all players, <u>PLAY READY GOLF!</u> Rules Officials will monitor pace and issue Pace of Play Penalties when necessary.
TIES:	Weather and time permitting, ties for first place will be broken by a sudden death play-off. All other ties will be broken in accordance with the USGA recommendations in Committee procedures 5A (6), Pg 403.

SUSPENSION OF PLAY: When play is suspended by the Committee for a dangerous situation, if the players are between the play of two holes, they must not resume play until the Committee has ordered a resumption of play. If they are in the process of playing a hole, they must discontinue play immediately and not resume play until the Committee has ordered a resumption of play. If a player fails to discontinue play immediately, they are disqualified unless circumstances warrant waiving the penalty as provided in Rule 5.7b. **The signal for suspending play due to a dangerous situation will be one long blast of the horn.** If possible, mark the position of your ball with a tee and proceed to a shelter or clubhouse.

(NOTE: Final day play will consist of two 9 hole rounds. If play is suspended on the final round and play cannot be completed by dark or because of a dangerous situation, the tournament will revert to the last 9 hole round completed by the entire division.)

RESUMPTION OF PLAY: Once the Committee has decided to resume play, an announcement will be made to all players. The signal to resume play will be two short blasts of the air horn unless otherwise instructed.

GOLF CARTS: There are no player electric carts allowed. Spectator carts are permitted at the discretion of the resort. They may be rented through the golf shop daily.

PULL CARTS: Pull carts are permitted in ALL age divisions - Boys and Girls.

CELL PHONES: Cell phones may be used to call for a ruling, enter or check scores or in case of emergency. Phones must be muted during play.
