Each summit participant (youth and adult) is responsible for acting in a way that ensures a positive experience for all. All participants are required to follow these guidelines and rules.

This completed form must accompany each summit registration!

Behavior Guidelines

- Participants shall be responsible for their words and actions.
- Participants shall be respectful of others.
- Participants shall follow directions from staff members.
- Participants shall be mindful and respectful when on their phones and avoid use during presentations (All phones are to be turned off during the Oratorical World Championships.)

Prohibited Behaviors

- Endangering their health and safety, that of other participants, staff, or volunteers.
- Stealing, damaging, or failing to care for university or personal property.
- Continual disruption of the program.
- Refusal to follow the behavior guidelines.
- Inappropriate physical contact.
- Using profanity or inappropriate language, or displaying clothing or other personal items with offensive content.
- Possession or use of illegal substances, tobacco, or alcohol.

Additional Fees:

- Lost keys to the residential halls (dorms) are **\$75**, and Lost access cards are **\$50**.
