- **Community Service Award** - 1 golfer selected

The \$1,000.00 scholarship award will be sent directly to the financial aid department of the recipient's chosen University, College or Technical School.

- Attach supporting documentation. The following items are the only items that will be accepted: current school transcript, most-recent grade report, and test results.
- Include two letters of recommendation from adults other than family members.

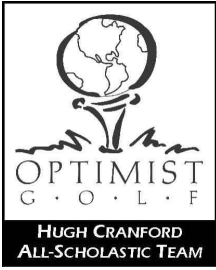
Application must be postmarked no later than April 1, 2019 and received in St. Louis Office by April 5, 2019. All applicants will be notified of their status by May 1, 2019.

Applications must be postmarked by April 1, 2019. Applicants will be notified of their status by May 1, 2018. Junior golfers selected to the team receive an automatic exemption into the 2019 Optimist International Junior Golf Championship which includes tournament entry, hotel accommodations and meals. Applicants must also show that they have acceptable golf experience to be able to play at the international level.
