



## CAMPAIGN RULES

It is the intention of the JOI Board of Directors that candidates and JOI members find the election process fun and rewarding. Fair and equal treatment of all candidates will ensure a memorable election. Therefore, everyone is asked to abide by the following Campaign Rules and Regulations.

1. Candidates' posters will only be placed in the dining hall.
2. No electioneering will be permitted inside the General Assembly Room.
3. **The maximum amount for campaign expenses to include materials, phone calls, give aways is not to exceed \$100.** This is to include any donations, monetary or in-kind. At the Candidates Briefing, each Candidate will submit an itemized report listing all campaign expenses. Candidates who exceed the limit will be disqualified.
4. Advisors/Chaperones may inform JOI members on safety and decorum issues, but will not advise members on how to vote. Likewise, the JOI Clubs Staff, JOI Board of Directors, JOI Clubs Committee, Advisors, Chaperones, Members of the Rules Committee, or guest speakers are not permitted to take part in candidate's campaign.
5. Voting instructions will be given at the beginning of the session.
6. Unprofessional behavior will not be tolerated during the election process.
7. Recruitment of JOI members as campaign volunteers is allowed.
8. Every member will respect the authority of the Convention Sergeant-at-Arms.
9. Candidates may not begin campaigning prior to the Candidate's Briefing.
10. The Candidate Qualifications Committee reserves the right to disqualify any candidate for any infraction of Campaign Rules.
11. No campaign materials may be worn or displayed by Candidates or anyone appearing on the stage.
