

TRAVELING TO THE OPTIMIST

Air Transportation:

PGA National Resort & Spa is easily accessible from many Florida airports. Here are the approximate distances from 4 international airports:

- Palm Beach International – 15 miles
- Ft. Lauderdale Hollywood Intl. – 60 miles
- Miami International – 80 miles
- Orlando International – 160 miles

Driving Directions:

PGA National Resort & Spa is located west of I-95 off PGA Boulevard at 400 Avenue of the Champions, Palm Beach Gardens, FL 33418.

Shuttle Service:

Yellow Brick Roads is the official transportation service of the Optimist International Junior Golf Championships for participants arriving to and departing from Palm Beach International Airport.



Transfer Fares

- \$32 per person, prepaid in US dollars, all ages for round-trip transfers on July 19, July 24 & July 29 before 9:30p.
- \$41 per person, prepaid in US dollars, all ages for round-trip transfers on any other day or after 9:30p on July 19, July 24 & July 29. Minimum 2 people and based on availability.
- \$22 per person, prepaid in US dollars, for one-way transfers on July 19, July 24 & July 29. Minimum 2 people and based on availability.

Yellow Brick Roads also offers transfers to/from Ft. Lauderdale and Miami international airports. Please call Yellow Brick Roads for prices.

Contact YBR at the number or e-mail listed below for reservations. Fees may be paid with Visa or MasterCard (cash only on-site). Please make sure you identify yourself as participants of THE OPTIMIST. In order to guarantee a spot, reservations must be made at least 24 hours in advance. On-site transportation available only on a limited basis.

When making your reservation, be prepared to provide the names of all travelers, your phone number, address, airline, flight number, arrival/departure times and credit card info. Upon arrival at the airport, proceed to the baggage claim area where you will see a YBR representative with the Optimist Golf logo. Check in to receive your transportation voucher prior to claiming your luggage.

RESORT & TOURNAMENT REGISTRATION

Upon arrival at PGA National, check in at the front desk for your housing arrangements. After checking into the resort, proceed to the tournament registration area (located in Vista A) to pick up your tournament packet, badges and important information. Tournament registration is scheduled for:

- Boys 10-15 & Girls 10-14: July 19 (10a-7p)
- Boys 16-18 & Girls 15-18: July 24 (10a-7p)

Late arrivals may register the following day in the tournament office (Vista A) starting at 7:00a.

ACCOMMODATIONS

Optimist Junior Golf will assign players and their guests to a hotel room. Players traveling by themselves will be paired with players of comparable age and gender. Roommate changes are not permitted.

Roommates are responsible for dividing and paying all personal room charges before their departure. Hotel room assignments will be available only upon arrival to PGA National. Do not call PGA National with questions regarding the tournament or accommodations.

Housing Policy:

Participants traveling alone to THE OPTIMIST will be housed in the main hotel at PGA National. Participants traveling with guests will be housed in either the main hotel or a club cottage. Optimist Golf reserves the right to house players and their guests at an offsite property should a need arise. Each family is limited to 2 hotel rooms in the resort or one club cottage. PGA NATIONAL PRO SHOP

The Pro Shop at PGA National Resort & Spa is open from 6:30a-7:30p on tournament days and 7a-6:30p on other days.

TOURNAMENT OFFICES

The Optimist tournament office, located in Vista A, will be open daily to assist players & guests. The scoring room, located in Masters B, is open only to tournament officials & players (parents and guests are not permitted).

MEALS

Each registered participant will receive a meal badge valid for five breakfasts and four dinners. Badges are valid only in the tournament dining room. Individual meal tickets will not be sold. For alternate dining options, there are several restaurants located on resort property.

Breakfasts:

Breakfasts take place from 6:15-9:30a in the Bella Lago room. Breakfasts include cereal, yogurt, bagels, donuts, eggs, fruit, coffee & juices.

Lunches:

Lunches are available for a fee or by using a lunch voucher. Lunch is served from 11:30a-2:30p in the Bella Lago room. Vouchers are also valid at golf course concession stands & carts all day and in the 19th Hole Grill from 2:30-4:30p.

Dinners:

Dinners take place in the PGA Ballroom at indicated times. See schedule on reverse for details.

PRACTICE ROUNDS

Players are entitled to one practice round at no additional cost on July 20 or 25. To arrange your practice round tee time, contact PGA National at teetimes@pgaresort.com or call (561) 627-1804, ext. 3. Additional practice rounds are available for \$66 per person (includes mandatory cart). This rate is valid 2 days prior to the start of the tournament. Report to the first tee at your scheduled practice round tee time. Carts, which may be rented in the pro shop, are allowed during practice rounds only. Parents and other guests may serve as caddies during practice rounds only.

TEE TIMES & RESULTS

Results and tee times for the following day's play will be posted each evening in the resort lobby and outside the tournament office. Tee times & results will also be available at golf.optimist.org.

MERCHANDISE

Optimist Golf will be selling a variety of souvenir items on-site during the championships including Optimist Golf T-shirts, caps, umbrellas, golf towels, accessories and more. Make sure to check out the selections in the Optimist tournament office.

GAME ROOM & LOUNGE

The Optimist Game Room & Lounge, located in Canterbury Room, is open from 4-10:45p daily. Video & pinball games, pool tables and a jukebox are free of charge to all participants and guests.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Players are required to adhere to the Optimist Golf Code of Conduct. Its purpose is to help participants grow and mature by understanding and accepting the consequences of their actions. The Code of Conduct is to be followed for the entire event starting at registration. Participants are expected to conduct themselves in proper fashion both on and off the course for the duration of the event. To read the entire Code of Conduct, go to golf.optimist.org.

CURFEW

Players must comply with the curfew of 11p. You must be in your room by the curfew and remain in your room for the entire night unless accompanied by an adult chaperone, parent or legal guardian. Nightly random room checks will be conducted.

SPECTATOR CODE OF CONDUCT

The following rules will be in effect for all spectators:

- Carts are not available to spectators for all practice & tournament rounds (no exceptions).
- Remain a minimum of 50 feet from all participants while following play.
- No advice is to be given to any player. A violation of this rule may result in stroke penalties or disqualification of the player.
- Do not walk in the fairways.
- Help spot golf balls.
- Allow rules officials to administer rulings. You will be brought into a situation only when asked.
- When on the course, turn off cell phones or turn ringers to the silent or vibrate mode.
